

## Module: m/01/101

*'Configuring the fire roll-call service...'*



The fire roll-call service performs **four** tasks:

- Polling **all** terminals for bookings.
- Monitoring any fire alarm input. **(optional)**
- Printing fire roll-call reports. **(optional)**
- Automatically unlocking access doors. **(optional)**

Configuration is **only** required if you wish to monitor fire alarm inputs to produce automatic roll-call reports.



Configuring this service is completed through the Fire Roll Call application. To run the application you can either <double-click> on the Fire Roll Call icon (on the Window's desktop):



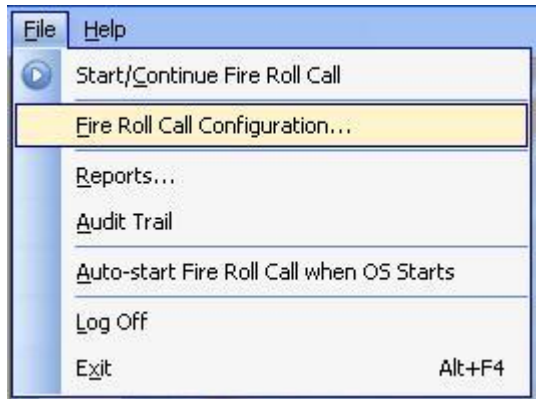
or select the Fire Roll Call application for the Program Files menu:

You will then be prompted to enter the Fire Roll Call Password:

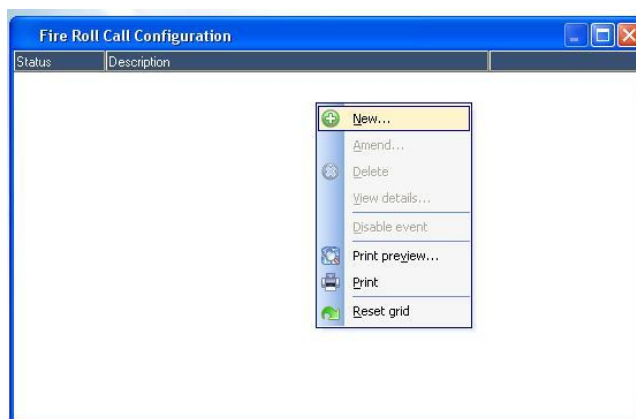

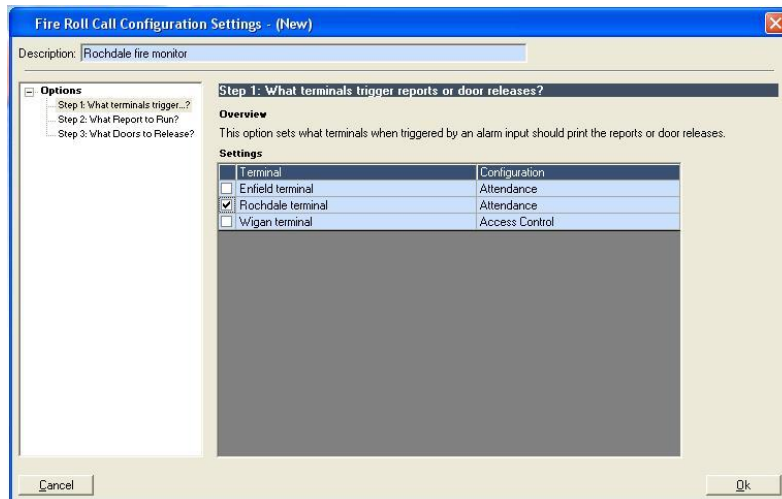
1. Select Fire Roll Call Configuration...



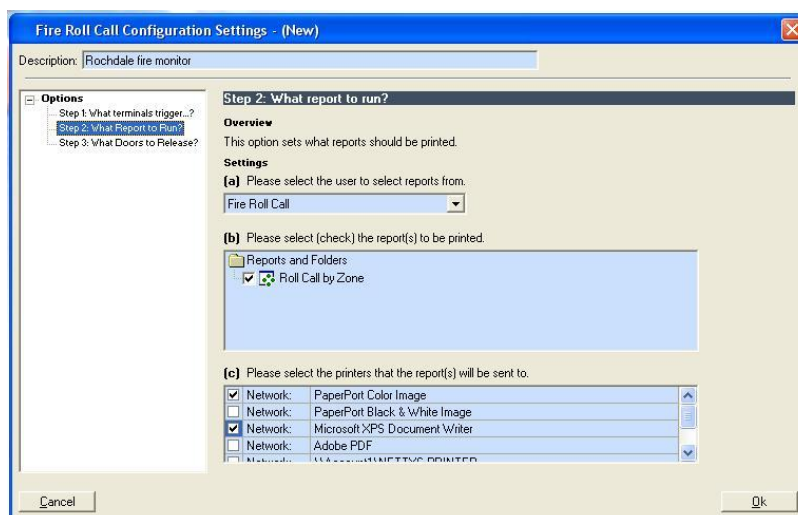
2. <Right-click> and select New...



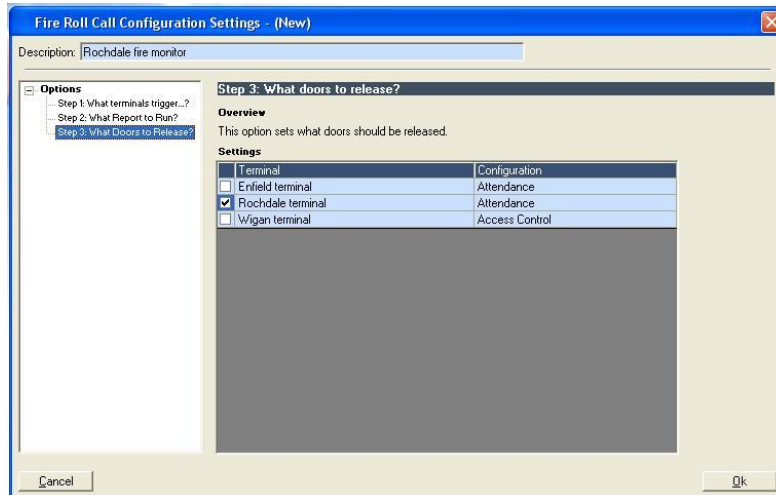
3. Next, select the terminal that is connected to the fire alarm monitoring system.



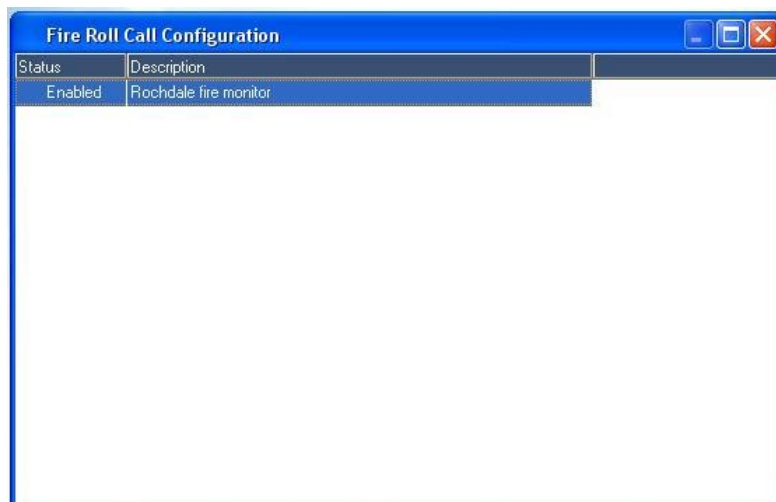
4. Then select which report to run when the fire alarm is triggered.



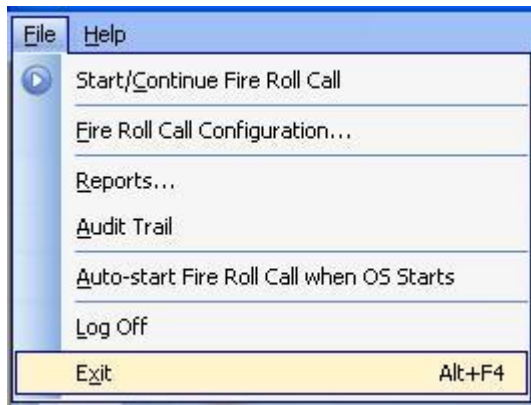
5. Next, select the doors to be released when the fire alarm is triggered. When all the doors have been selected, press <Ok>.



6. The Fire Roll Call monitor is now set.



7. Exit the Fire Roll Call application by selecting Exit.



The Fire Alarm Roll Call will not work until you start this service, (see module m/01/008).
