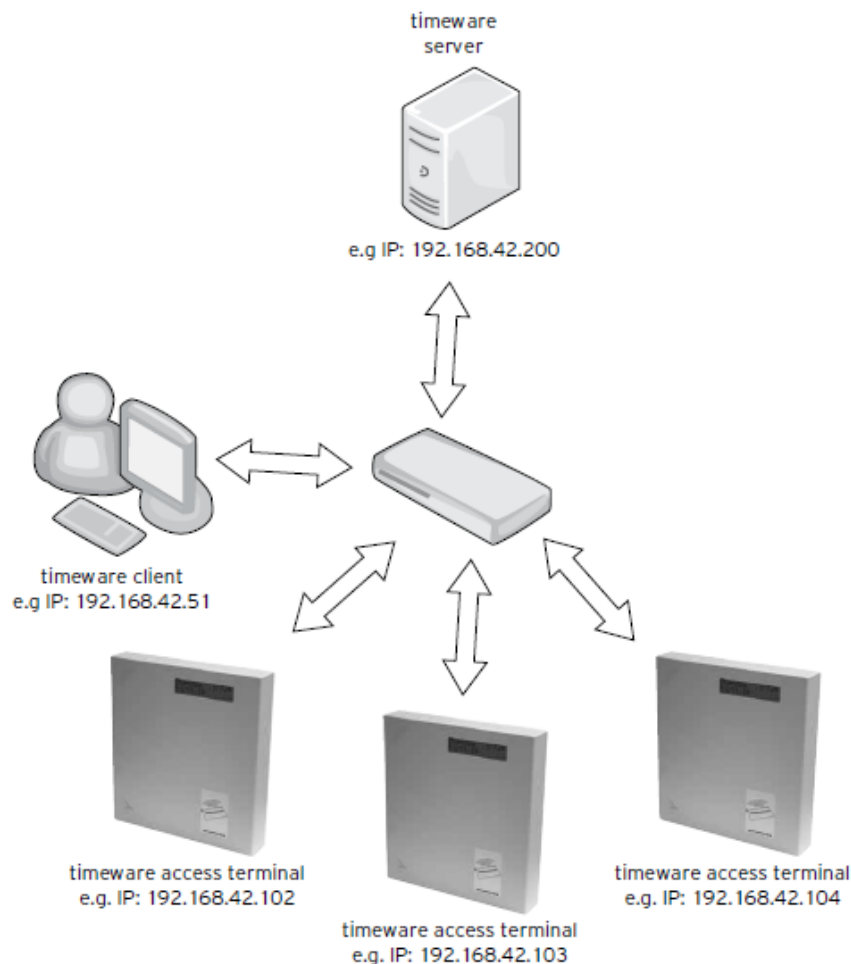

### *'Understanding timeware<sup>®</sup> access control ...'*

The timeware<sup>®</sup> access control facility is simple in design but very effective in operation. People are allocated an access profile which determines where (and when) they may pass through turnstiles and doors controlled by the timeware access terminals.

Profiles may be created in advance for new starters and visitors and access badges or fobs can be programmed to 'expire' at a preset date and time



Finally, a history of people's movements may be stored for up to a year on the timeware<sup>®</sup> server.
